




MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT  
Between

CLIFTON SANITATION DISTRICT  
CONCERNING  
PARTICIPATION IN THE  
COLORADO ENVIRONMENTAL LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

- I. The Colorado Environmental Leadership Program (program) is a voluntary program that provides the regulated environmental community with incentives to go beyond basic compliance with environmental laws and regulations. Applicants must meet all program requirements to obtain admission into the program.
- II. Acceptance into the program renders the participant eligible for various incentives set forth in department policy; however, the program does not guarantee to the participant all the incentives listed in the policy.
- III. By entering into this Memorandum of Agreement (agreement), the department recognizes that Clifton Sanitation District has met all of the application requirements of the program.
- IV. By entering into this agreement, Clifton Sanitation District agrees to abide by the requirements for participating in the program and to any commitments made to the department during the application negotiation process.
- V. This agreement shall expire three years from the date of issuance.
